Our 13th year brings a new format to the Kevin's annual fund raising for childhood cancer research. Since participation in golf and the dinner has been declining in recent years, the fund's leadership team has decided to concentrate exclusively on fund raising outreach going forward.

Kevin's Fund has raised more than \$400,000 in the past twelve years to support the work of Dr. James Amatruda University of Texas SW Medical Center, in Dallas, TX. Dr. Amatruda researches childhood cancers such as Ewing's Sarcoma, which threatened the life of George Platt's grandson, Kevin Weir, in 2005. Kevin has recovered and thrived, and is now a freshman at Austin College in Sherman, TX. He is following a pre-med curriculum and is planning to be a pediatric oncologist.
